YOUR KIDDO'S HOBBIES CHANGE WITH THE TIDE and that means last year's arcade-themed birthday might not jive with her newly discovered artist within. To help you plan a party around her latest fancy, we compiled our annual list of Best For Families: Kids' Parties awards. This year's winners, chosen by you, include venues that cater to Broadway-bound babes and little gymnasts; indoor playgrounds perfect for middle-of-summer or winter birthdays; and parties that come to you because we can't think of anything better than front-row seats in the comfort of your living room (or backyard). Find the package best suited to your kid's growing personality and watch the memories unfold.

FOR HISTORY LOVERS

HERITAGE FARMSTEAD MUSEUM

Turn the dial to the late 1800s for a birthday party at Heritage Farmstead Museum. For the littlest farmhands — ages 3 and younger — parties begin with story time then games like gathering apples and feeding the chickens. Those older than 3 also get to dress up and play with era cooking utensils, sewing machines and more in the History House, as well as participate in sack races and lasso pretend steer. And kids 5 and older follow a map to find buried treasure on the property too. All parties include a party facilitator who sets up and leads the activities. Add tractor rides for an additional charge. \$200 for 10 guests.

Pinstack is a haven for bowlers, video game lovers and adrenaline junkies of all ages.
